
Toy Case

Steps to Complete **Before** Your Pre-Assessment Call with Study Staff

PLUG INTO SAFETY!

Follow these tips to begin electrical safety in your home:



Never overload wall outlets or power strips.



Keep cord-and-plug connected electrical devices away from water.

Step 1: Set up the Dream Case



Antenna/Front of Dream Case

Open cover



Plug in power cord



Plug power cord into the wall.



Step 2: Position Dream Case next to a window. The Dream Case should be placed on a table with the antenna facing the window. The dream case should be at the height of the window. If you cannot find a good position, study staff will help you during your pre-assessment call.

Step 3: Prepare for Your Zoom Call with Study Staff




If the iPad Screen is black, click the button on the top




Once the screen lights up, slide your finger from the bottom of the screen upward

Note: A stand for the iPad is provided but does not need to be used until the assessment


Step 3 Continued...



The Dream Case will provide WiFi to the iPad. If you just plugged in the Dream Case, you may need to wait a few minutes.



Open the Zoom application.



Locate the Meeting ID. Type in the credentials for the meeting.

Set up the Camera Case



Place camera case
on table or chair.



Flip open the two
buckles on the case.




Open camera case.

Pick up the camera by the black battery in the back. Try not to grab the white part.



Two hands are even better!

Take out the camera and place it in a secure location.



Repeat these steps for the second camera.




Use the power button to turn on the cameras.

****Note:** as soon as the cameras turn on, they will begin recording. All recordings are stored on a secure DVR.

Find Good Spots for the Cameras at a Table and on the Floor

Please find a spot where you will be able to position the iPad in front of you and your child with the cameras on both sides.

The cameras should not be higher than eye level while you are sitting on the floor.

Turning the Cameras off

Use the button on top to turn the cameras off. Pick up the camera by the black battery in the back. Try not to grab the white part.



Place camera case on table or chair.



Put the cameras back into their case with the black battery going in first.

Close the camera case.



Close the two buckles on the case. Press firmly until you hear a snap.




Please find a secure location to store the camera case.

Reminders

Keep the Dream Case where it is and plugged in until your assessment, if possible. If you are unable to do so, please store it in a safe location.

Have Your Child Wear LENA




Hold the power button until the screen says 'Paused'
